

UIC ON-CAMPUS HOUSING INFORMATION FOR TUTORIUM IN INTENSIVE ENGLISH STUDENTS

APPLYING

Fill out the campus housing application, and return it to the Tutorium.

DO NOT PAY THE \$50 APPLICATION FEE AT THIS TIME

The university Housing Office charges a \$50 Application fee (nonrefundable). After you arrive on campus, the Housing Office will add the \$50 fee to your total housing bill.

The Tutorium office will email a confirmation message to you after we receive the application. The Housing Office makes room assignments shortly before the start of the session, so you will get your room assignment after you arrive on campus.

MOVE IN DATES

At no extra charge, you can move in the Wednesday before the first day of the contract for Fall Session and the day before the first day of the contract for Spring and Summer sessions. For an extra charge, early move in is possible depending on availability. Contact the Tutorium Office for details. You may plan to stay with friends or in an area hotel from your arrival date until the move-in. There is a list of recommended temporary housing on our website www.uic.edu/depts/tie. The Tutorium Office does not arrange temporary housing for students.

COSTS

All students are assigned to Single Student Residence (SSR) for Fall, Spring and Summer Sessions. For Fall and Spring Sessions, the cost is approximately between \$4,400 and \$5,000 per session, depending on the type of room. For the 12-week Summer Session, it is between \$2,550 and \$2,800. For descriptions, floor plans and photos of SSR, visit the website: <http://www.housing.uic.edu/halls/ssr/index.php>. Most Tutorium students are assigned to a room with 1 or 2 roommates. You will receive your exact room assignment when you arrive to the housing office to check in.

ROOMS AND FACILITIES

The rooms are air-conditioned, carpeted, and furnished with a bed, closet space, desk, chair, wastebasket, window blinds, and drawers. You must provide your own linens (sheets for a twin extra long bed), pillow, towels, toiletry items, telephone, extension cords, power strip with surge protector, desk lamp, floor lamp, laundry detergent, alarm clock. Go to <http://www.housing.uic.edu/bring.php> for details. For all room assignments, you will have your own single bedroom and share a bathroom and kitchen with roommates. Family housing is not available to Tutorium students.

MEAL PLANS

Rooms in SSR have kitchens, so the contracts do NOT include a meal plan. However, if you want to eat in campus cafeterias, meal plans are available. The costs of different plans depend on your needs. There is a small administrative fee.

BILLING, PAYMENT AND REFUNDS

You will receive monthly bills by email after you have moved in and classes have started. You will learn how to log in to your housing account and pay your bills after classes begin. For refund payments, complete a change of address information at the Central Housing Office and the Tutorium Office to ensure you get the refund.

CANCELLATION

Please notify the Tutorium before beginning of the session that you cannot attend or that you wish to cancel your housing contract.
